



Trial Indoor Ciudad de Lisboa

ADAM RAGA (GAS GAS), 2nd IN LISBON, KEEPS THE LEAD OF THE INDOOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

Lisbon, Portugal, 26 February 2006 – The reigning Indoor Trial World Champion and this year’s present leader, Adam Raga (GAS GAS) has finished in the second place at the Trial Indoor Ciudad de Lisboa after winning both the first and the second lap, although two fives very close to the end left him in the second place in the final standings.

“I am not worried about this indoor’s standings at all, my situation in the championship is still good. You can’t always win, and less with two fives in such a tight event as Lisbon. We have enough margin in the championship, so we will have to wait and see what happens in South America,” said a confident Raga right after the end of the Lisbon event.

The second GAS GAS rider in the event, Jeroni Fajardo, was unlucky and had to change his bike in the middle of his performance, finishing quite far back, although he keeps his chances for a top-three Championship finish. The next round, the tenth of the season, will be the “Gran Premio Cidade de Sao Paulo” in Brazil, and will be held on Saturday, 4 March.
