

9th World Championship Trial: Victory of Alexz Wigg (GG) In Junior

ADAM RAGA (GAS GAS), WINS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Kramolin (República Checa), 15 July, 2007. – Adam Raga (GAS GAS) has won a victory in the trial in the Czech Republic, held today 120 km south of Prague. The triumph of the current world champion, after an exceptional second lap in which he obtained the only 0 of the race, represents his second victory of the season in the outdoor world championship and number 21 of his records in this championship.

After tying at 2 points with Bou in the first round, Adam Raga made an extraordinary effort in the second, which gave him a victory in a relatively easy trial in which the errors were very difficult to recover from. "I was able to get the most out of the second lap and that was how we could win. The level is quite high and again today not making mistakes was the key to winning. I'm happy and hope to keep on struggling like today for victory," says, Adam, feeling reinforced after this demonstration.

The Czech trial has brought excellent results for the GAS GAS team, since Adam's victory was accompanied by a win by young Briton Alexz Wigg in Junior and second place for Ross Danby in the Youth Cup. Wigg is second in the world championship with his GAS GAS 125, right behind Michael Brown, while Spaniard Alfredo Gómez, fourth today, and Danby from Great Britain lead this category with a big difference over third place. Saturday the first female world championship trial was held, in which Rebecca Cook (GG) finished third.

The next world championship trial will be held on 29 July in the British town of Hawkstone Park.
