

6th round of the 2007 Spanish Trial Championship: La Nucia

UNSTOPPABLE ADAM RAGA (GAS GAS) IN THE SPANISH SERIES

Alfredo Gómez (GG), the Spanish Trial Champion in the Senior B class

La Nucia, Alicante, 21 October 2007.— Adam Raga has achieved another win in the penultimate valid round for the Spanish Trial Championship, which was held in La Nucia. The GAS GAS man has thus won four back-to-back events, climbing to the top of the provisional standings with 6 points over his closest rival Toni Bou, and 30 over third-place-man Albert Cabestany. The Spanish series will have to wait until the last round, to be held in Sant Fruitós del Bages, Barcelona, on 11 November to know the 2007 champion.

«Today's event was very tough. We had many uphill sections and it rained last night, so everything was very slippery and it was easy to make mistakes. To make things worse, I came up first in the starting order draw, so I had to go through all the sections first. The final result is very good if we take all this into account » commented Adam when he arrived at the paddock. The GAS GAS team had a double reason for celebration as, apart from their number one rider's win, Alfredo Gómez sentenced the Senior B Spanish Trial Championship after finishing second, with a total of 117 points against the 84 of his closest rival David Millán. This class also saw the win of another GAS GAS rider, Adrián Pastoriza, who added the icing to the cake. In the Cadet class, the member of the Spea Tarrés Team Pol Tarrés was second.
